
















GRAMMAR Countable and uncountable nouns

> Oh, nol I do not want to eat that strange food. I do not like rice and raw fish. I want to eat with a knife and fork, not chopsticks!






Max, it's good to try new foods. There are so many bored if you always eat the same food. Stop being so difficult.


