The little one stops to eat some **fries** . . .



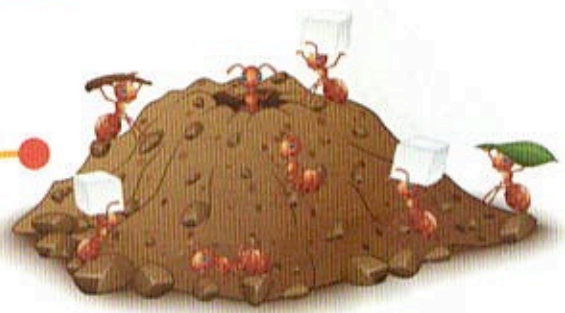
